City Clerk Angela Wirth informed the Mayor and Council the millage rate is different than first presented at the August 14, 2023, called meeting. There was a mistake on the PT32, and the millage rollback rate was changed from 11.662% to 11.549%. Since there was not enough time to have another called meeting on the change to the millage, but since the consensus of the Council was to go with the rollback, the ad was submitted and ran with the 11.549% rollback. Mayor Maefield asked for a motion to approve the 11.549% rollback for the FY 2023 Millage Rate. Mayor Pro-Tem Bruce Davis made the motion to approve the 11.549% rollback as the FY 2023 Millage rate. Councilmember Crystal Johns seconded the motion, all in favor, motion carried.

Councilmember Crystal Johns brought forth discussion of the Trunk or Treat Day and why was it decided on a Friday and the Georgia/Florida game weekend. After much discussion Councilmember Crystal Johns made the motion to move Trunk or Treat from Friday, October 27,

2023, to Tuesday, October 31, 2023. (Councilmember Deloise McFadden seconded the motion,
