Items to Consider for Approval

- Councilman Richard Johns made the motion to approve tonight's agenda. Councilmember Deloise McFadden seconded the motion, all in favor, carried. - Councilman Richard Johns made the motion to approve the October 3, 2022, minutes with minor corrections. Mayor Pro-Tem Bruce Davis seconded the motion, all in favor, carried. I. Unfinished Business

a. Sanitation Pricing for renewal contract

City Clerk Angela Wirth brought forth the pricing that was given when calling sanitation services: Republic Services-\$13.75 residential/\$18.89 commercial; Waste Management (ballpark figure) \$24.00-\$29.00; Ryland (ballpark figure) \$13.00 to \$19.00. Public Works-City Manager Tom Wirth gives the monthly report; new sewer plant construction bids to be opened at City Hall on December 6, 2022; Hurst is working on the FY 2022 Audit; Mayor Maefield and City Manager Tom Wirth picked up the \$1 million-dollar CDBG check; and there is still one full time position open.
